

**NOTICE OF AVAILABILITY AND REQUEST FOR PUBLIC COMMENT ON  
DRAFT ENVIRONMENTAL ASSESSMENT  
OBSTRUCTION REMOVAL PROJECT  
CANANDAIGUA AIRPORT (IUA)**

A *Draft Environmental Assessment (DEA)* was prepared to evaluate potential impacts resulting from the Obstruction Removal Project at the Canandaigua Airport. The project includes the removal of vegetation identified as airspace obstructions and the proposed aviation easement or possible acquisitions for portions of eight neighboring parcels near the Airport. Portions of the proposed project are located within wetlands regulated by the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers.
