<b>Hangar Fee</b> is charged when aircraft is stored in the MFC hangar.					
<b>Hangar Fee</b> is also charged whenever aircraft is placed in the MFC hangar for a few hours, such as during inclement weather for de-icing purposes.					
<b>Overnight Fee</b> is waived for the first night for single-engine airplanes with gross weight less than 6,000 lbs with any fuel purchase.
